PROPOSITION TIGERS

Shall the Board of Education of the Cape Girardeau School District No. 63 borrow money in the amount of \$30,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, expanding, improving, furnishing and equipping school sites, buildings and related facilities for school purposes, including the expansion and renovation of Central Middle School, Phase II building renovations for Alma Schrader Elementary and Jefferson Elementary, and district-wide energy efficiency upgrades, and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6647 per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of real and personal property.
